Membership Dues

First year dues for a new member are \$600 for MCA of Houston. There after membership dues are \$1200 annually or \$100 per month. Membership dues are calculated separately for MCA of Texas at the rate of \$0.015/productive man hour (minimum annual dues are \$200, and maximum is \$1500), and for MCA of America at the rate of \$0.05/productive man hour (minimum annual dues are \$600 and maximum is \$11,500).
